156th ANNUAL INTERNATIONAL EXHIBITION PROSPECTUS

Exhibition Dates April 3 – 28, 2023

The Annual International Exhibition of the American Watercolor Society is juried by Signature Members who have been elected by the AWS membership.

ELIGIBILITY

The International Exhibition is open to all artists working in water media on paper (Yupo is permitted). No other surfaces accepted.

- Watercolor, Acrylic, Casein, Gouache, Egg tempera
- No collage, pastels, digital images, any form of print or reproductions.
- **Artist's original work only. No class work. No work done under supervision.** No copies or likenesses of another artist's work including published source *or reference work not attributable to the artist.*
- **One entry** per artist, except for Signature Candidates. See page 3.
- No work previously exhibited in the International Exhibition may be submitted. Work submitted by an Associate Member to the Online Associate Members Exhibition **IS** eligible. (including work *accepted* into the Associate Exhibition)
- Maximum **frame** size is **44"** in any direction. (**height or width**)
- Minimum **image** size (do not include mat or frame) is **140** square inches (multiply **image** height x width).

ABOUT YOUR DIGITAL IMAGE:

- Digital file must be in JPG format
- Image must be at least 1800 pixels on the longer side.
- File size is up to 3.5MB
- Show only the image, no frame or mat.
- Images that are not correctly formatted are liable to exclusion from jurying.

TO SUBMIT YOUR ENTRY ONLINE:

- Login to your AWS member account ("Login" tab at www.americanwatercolorssociety.org) **You must login FIRST and then you will see the submission tab in your member account.**

- If you submitted an entry in the last nine years, online or not, you already have an AWS online account. **If you already have one DO NOT create a new one.**
- If you do not already have one, go to www.americanwatercolorssociety.org and click on the "Login" tab. New account instructions are on the right hand side of this page.
- If your membership is not current you must either renew prior to entering or enter as a Non-Member.

LIABILITY

All artists whose work is selected for exhibition will receive instructions for shipping and delivery in the **Acceptance Notice**. Although the utmost care will be taken in handling works of art, AWS and/or AWS's representatives and the Salmagundi Club will not be responsible for damage or loss, whatever the cause. Accepted artists release AWS, AWS's representatives, DAD, Inc. and/or the Salmagundi Club from all liability with respect to loss or damage to the artist's works of art.

It is suggested that artists carry their own insurance, in proper limits. Submitting a work of art to this exhibition shall constitute an agreement on the part of the artist to comply fully with the conditions and terms set forth in this Prospectus as well as in the Acceptance Form.

EXHIBITION - PROCEDURES AND REGULATIONS

All paintings become subject to the procedures and regulations of AWS upon receipt in New York. No painting received for exhibition, either in the New York Exhibition or the Traveling Exhibition, may be removed for any reason prior to the end of the exhibition(s).

The **Traveling Exhibition**, consisting of 40 paintings, will be selected for a nationwide tour of museums and galleries. All paintings for which **Permission to Travel** has been granted by the artists are eligible for selection. Both the New York Exhibition and the Traveling Exhibition are handled by professionals and all due care is taken to ensure the safety of every painting. All work accepted for exhibition will be included in the 156th Annual Exhibition Catalog. All exhibiting artists, whether AWS members or not, will receive a copy of the catalog. Images of accepted work may be used by AWS in promotional material.

SALES

- All paintings will be considered for sale at the price set forth by the artist unless marked **NFS** (Not for Sale) or **0** (zero). *Prices may not be changed or withdrawn once accepted into the exhibition.*
- Any painting sold in the New York Exhibition or Traveling Exhibition is subject to a 35% donation to AWS.

SIGNATURE MEMBERSHIP

Any artist, who has exhibited in two AWS International Exhibitions, may be considered for candidacy as a Signature Member. If accepted into a third Annual Exhibition, the artist will become a Signature Member. If you have been accepted into two previous AWS International Exhibitions, email: Susan Weintraub, Membership Chair, at: s.weintraub@americanwatercolorssociety.org.

Specify the years of acceptances in your email. You will be invited to submit two paintings to the next AWS International Exhibition which will be evaluated by the Jury of Selection. One of the two paintings must be accepted into the next Exhibition to receive Signature Status.

Those not elected may reapply for candidacy the following year. Those who reapply must again write as outlined above.

Associate Members also have the opportunity to submit to a yearly online show for Associates only, the Associate Members Online Exhibition.
